The IIM is a teacher/student friendly way to breeze through the research process:

- Step 5: Goal Evaluation
- Step 6: Product
- Step 7: Presentation

In this workshop, teachers will learn the fundamental skills of research that will allow them to teach students to conduct independent research studies. Participants will acquire a set of skills to instruct students on the process of gathering, analyzing and sharing information.

Through this process students will learn that:

- ★ Research is a sequential process.
- ★ Research is used to answer questions.
- ★ There are many sources for information.
- ★ They must cite their sources using a standard format for their bibliography.
- ★ They need to put information in their own words (No Plagiarism).
- ★ Information must be organized for use in a product.
- ★ They should share what they have learned with an appropriate audience.
