Program Information

Am I eligible for the Project P.a.C.E. Alternative Certification Program (ACP)?

Eligibility Requirements

- o Bachelor's Degree
- 2.5 GPA or 2.75 in last 60 hours of all coursework (Use online GPA calculator if needed)
- Basic Skills in Reading, Written and Oral Communication and Mathematics
 - 6 hours of English Language Arts coursework from an accredited university whose language of instruction is English
 - 3 hours of college level mathematics or equivalent
- o Cannot have taught for 3 years or more on a permit or certificate
- Cannot have been admitted to another Educator Preparation Program (EPP)-University or ACP (Transfer possible with completed PACT exams in a different area)
- o Pass Pre-Admission Content Tests (PACT)
- Access to a computer, internet, and e-mail

Out of Country Basic Skills Requirements

- TOEFL iBT speaking score of at least 24 speaking, 22 listening, 22 reading, and 21 for writing to demonstrate English language proficiency. Test information at http://www.ets.org/toefl/.
- Transcript evaluation into US degree equivalency by a credential evaluation service

What is the Process for Program Acceptance?

- 1. Complete PACT Content Area Testing
 - Registering for PACT Content Exams

2. Application Process

- o Fill out online application
- Pay \$40.00 non-refundable application fee through link sent by program staff
- o Submit official transcripts from ALL universities and colleges attended
 - CTE Candidates submit SOQ, copy and verification of licenses,
 - Foreign Transcripts See TEA website:
 http://tea.texas.gov/Texas Educators/Certification/Out-ofState Certification/Foreign Credential Evaluation Services/

3. Screening and Selection

- Submit PACT Scores
- Transcript Review for Suggested Certification Areas
- o Program Check for Eligibility and Basic Skills
- o Interview by Program Staff
- Pay \$35.00 TEA Technology Fee (Admitted on or after September 1, 2018)
- Pay \$295 Pre-Service Summer Institute Training Fee

What is the P.a.C.E. Coursework Schedule?

Pre-Service Training

- o Program Introduction/Orientation
- o Quick Start Online Coursework and
- Field-based Experience Observations (30 hours required prior to teaching)
- Summer Institute (150 program hours required prior to teaching) –Note: All candidates are required to complete 150 hours of course work and 30 fieldbased experience observation hours prior to teaching students unless they have been designated as a "late hire".

In-Service Training

- Ongoing Professional Saturdays- September through May
- Thursday Evening Seminars- September through April
