


What is screencastify?

A Chrome extension that gives you the ability to record your computer screen with audio and an embedded webcam. You can record, edit and share the videos created. The recordings can then be shared by email, embeded code, YouTube, Google classroom and more. You can easily create a GIF or an MP3.








Understanding the Options

If you click on the extension again during recording a different drop down of options will appear.

These include:

- A. The recording time length
- B. What is being recorded
- C. Delete the recording
- D. Restart the recording
- E. Pause the recording
- F. End the recording



Creating a Video

1. Click on the screencastify extension 
2. Choose the criteria for your recording
 - a. Tab
 - b. Desktop
 - c. Webcam
3. Click record and wait for the countdown
4. START recording
5. Use the tools provided (bottom left corner)
6. END recording
7. Go to the Editor (to edit the video)



Understanding the Tools Provided



- End Recording (ALT+Shift+R)
- Restart Recording
- Pause Recording (ALT+Shift+P)
- Resume Recording (ALT+Shift+P)
- Mouse Pointer (ALT+M)
 - Focus Mouse (ALT+F)
 - Hide cursor when not moved
 - Highlight Clicks
- Pen (ALT+P)
 - Change the color
- Eraser (ALT+E)
 - Wipe screen clear (ALT+Z)
- Hide Tools (ALT+T)
- Unhide Tools (ALT+T)



Editing a Video

- When you finish recording it will open another tab
- You may edit here or use the options on the left hand side.
 - Google Drive
 - Share
 - Download
- When using ECISD Google account videos can only be viewed with people at ecisd.
- You are allowed to cut the video here or if you want more edit options click on the Open in Editor tab.

Editing a Video

To begin using the edit options you need to click on the clip.

Tips:

- Use the space bar to press pause or play
- Use left and right arrow keys to make precise pauses

Options:

- Change the title of the video
- Cut clip (Ctrl+B)
- Crop video image (Ctrl+Shift+C)
- Add Text (Ctrl+O)
- Delete (Del)
- Play/Pause (Space Bar)
- Zoom/Unzoom
- Add another clip using Google Drive or your desktop (Ctrl+A)
- Undo (Ctrl+Z)
- Redo (Ctrl+Y)
- Export



Why MP3?


- Use when you want to only record your voice

 - To read a slide show
 - To create a podcast
 - To read a passage with the students



Why GIF?

- When you want to record your screen in a loop with no sound.
- Examples:
 - To demonstrate steps
 - To provide a fun activity/clip for students (like a claymation)




































Sharing to Google Classroom

To share a video:

- Click on Share to Classroom
- Click the class you want to share to
- Click the action (create assignment, etc)
- Write in instructions if needed
- Change the classes or students you would like to send it to
- Check the video to make sure it is the correct one
- Post the action along with the video
- Click view to see the action in Google Classroom

Sharing to Google Classroom

To share a GIF & MP3:

- At Screencastify screen download as a GIF or a MP3
- Go to Google Classroom
- Click the action (create assignment, etc)
- Write in instructions if needed
- Change the classes or students you would like to send it to
- Click ADD
- Click from Drive then upload the GIF or MP3
- Check the GIF or MP3 to make sure it is the correct one
- Post the action along with the GIF or MP3

How to share a QR Code:

- Click on the video on screencastify
- Click generate QR Code
- Click download
- Save to desktop or drag into your Google Drive
- Go to Google Classroom
- Click the action (create assignment, etc)
- Write in instructions if needed
- Change the classes or students you would like to send it to
- Click ADD
- Upload a file or click Google Drive
- Find the QR Code and Click insert

Tips

- Configure your mic volume and test the volume before recording.
- Configure the resolution to be 1920x1080px
- If webcam is embedded ensure that the background is professional.
- ALWAYS make sure to rewatch the finalized video before uploading to YouTube or Google Classroom.
- Check if the QR code works.
- Make an introduction slide with PowerPoint.
- If you choose to crop the video do this before doing any other edits to the video.

- Click DONE







The settings will not automatically be set each time you must change them to how you want them.







Find free-to-use images

When you do a Google Search, you can filter your results to find images, videos, or text that you have permission to use. To do this, use an Advanced Search filter called "usage rights" that lets you know when you can use, share, or modify something you find online.

Find images, text, and videos you can reuse

1. Go to [Advanced Image Search](#) for images or [Advanced Search](#) for anything else.
2. In the "all these words" box, type what you want to search.
3. In the "Usage rights" section, use the drop-down to choose what kind of license you want the content to have.
4. Select **Advanced Search**.

Note: Before reusing content, make sure that its license is legitimate and check the exact terms of reuse. For example, the license might require that you give credit to the image creator when you use the image. Google can't tell if the license label is legitimate, so we don't know if the content is lawfully licensed.

Types of usage rights

- **Free to use or share:** Allows you to copy or redistribute its content if the content remains unchanged.
- **Free to use share or modify:** Allows you to copy, modify, or redistribute in ways specified in the license.
- **Commercially:** If you want content for commercial use, be sure to select an option that includes the word "commercially."
