


Exceptional children who are military-connected face unique challenges.

Exceptional children are defined as those who qualify for special education services or gifted education services to maximize their individual potential.









Added Challenges Due to COVID-19

- · Stress caused by ill family members or friends
- Stress caused by economic concerns
- Stress caused by disruption in regular routine or the switch to remote learning
- Stress caused by possible regression and/or loss of academic and functional skills
- Difficulties with wearing (and removing) a mask
- Sensory issues associated with wearing a mask
- Communication difficulties for children with exceptional needs
- Frustrations or behavioral issues arising from the need to wear a mask (reminders, etc.)

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Project Based Learning



- Investigate Real World Problems
- Build Critical Thinking Skills
- Encourage Inquiry and Skepticism
- Embrace the Arts

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Strengths-Based Approach: A Paradigm Shift

- · Avoid deficit model planning
- Use student abilities to help improve areas of challenge
- Build assignments around what the student can do
- Help students identify and leverage their strengths - all children have strengths and abilities



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Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)

- Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE)
- Appropriate Evaluation
- Individualized Education Program (IEP)
- Least Restrictive Environment (LRE)
- Parent and student participation in decision making
- Procedural Safeguards

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504 Plan (Section 504 of the Rehab Act)



- Children with disabilities can be eligible for classroom accommodations under Section 504
- The definition of a disability under Section 504 is broader than under IDEA
- A 504 Plan reduces barriers and provides access to the learning environment
- Disability must substantially limit one or more major life activity including learning and behavior
