 - Real Goal: To have students complete top 6 courses by Thanksgiving or first week of December
 - The grant funding this initiative needs the college to demonstrate that the level of knowledge gained using the website has increased
 - On the back end, our Director of Career and Employer Services who also runs our Financial Wellness Center (<u>https://southtexascollege.igrad.com/</u>) has access to see what is automatically populating as students click to navigate and complete the courses – shows which courses have been completed and a prepost measure of their financial literacy
