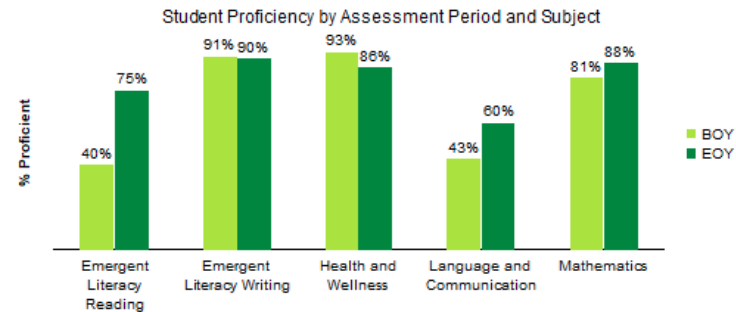
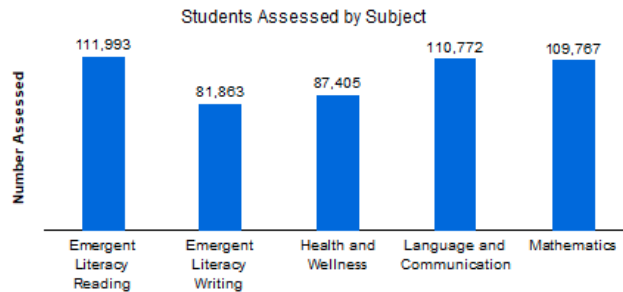

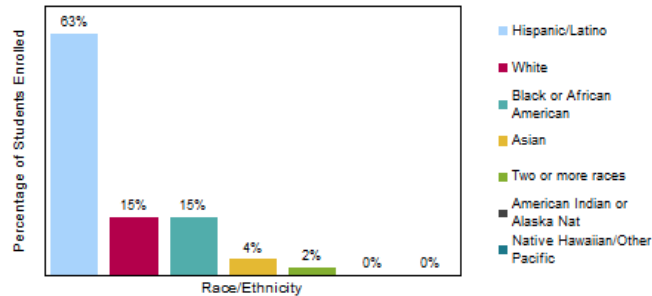

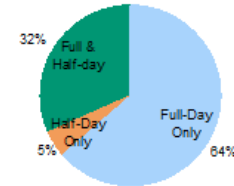

ECDS Program information for public pre-k (See TAA letter 10/29/2020)

- ❑ **All Public pre-K programs will submit demographic, classroom link information, special program information, and funding source information in the TSDS collection.**
- ❑ All Public pre-K programs that administer an assessment from the Commissioner's List of Approved Prekindergarten Assessment Instruments, will submit BOY and EOY assessment data through the TSDS collection.

Reminders:

- ❑ 4 year PK students must be assessed and submitted.
- ❑ Mixed Classrooms of 3 and 4 year olds, then also submit the PK assessments for PK 3 if available.
- ❑ PK3 Only Classrooms do not have to be assessed, but if they were, then they **MUST** be part of ECDS

- **Data promotion, verification and completion:**
 - LEAs should start loading/promoting ECDS pre-K data, run business validations, and review reports as soon as possible to identify any data issues and verify data counts.
 - LEAs can start completing their submissions on **May 9, 2022**.
 - The following business validations are currently available to verify an LEA's course section data where the pre-K school type of 'Public pre-K Licensed Child Care', 'Public pre-K Head Start', or 'In District Partnership' has at least one Child Care Operation Number: 10050-0004, 10010-0021

- **Assessments:**

- LEAs should reach out to their ECDS pre-K assessment vendor regarding any issues with their assessment results. Pre-K assessment results will **NOT** be sent directly to TEA.

- **Reports:**

- The **ECD0-000-007** report will be updated in the **May 6, 2022** software release to show the Child Care Operation number(s) submitted by LEAs reporting pre-K partnerships.
- ESCs and LEAs can run the **ECD0-000-003** Assessment Pre-K Sources report for 2020-2021 to see 2021-2022 KG assessment readiness results compared to same students enrolled in a pre-K program for 2020-2021.

Early Learning Partnerships

- Early learning partnerships are formal collaborations between LEAs, and private early learning centers (ELCs) or Head Start centers.
- The resulting partnership allows an LEA to dual enroll children and provide prekindergarten and/or additional comprehensive, wrap-around services.
- Partnerships benefit a wide range of stakeholders, families and children, LEAs, ELCs, and the Early Childhood community.

Receiving accurate partnership data will allow TEA to:

- **Have a better understanding of the PK partnership landscape in Texas:**
 - Number of LEAs who have partnerships
 - Which LEAs have partnerships
 - Number of childcare providers participating in partnerships
- **Know where to focus efforts to support partnership sustainability and implementation:**
 - Analyze data by region
 - Collaborate with the Texas Workforce Commission to connect partnership specialists with LEAs/ESCs for technical assistance

Reporting Public Pre-K Partnerships in ECDS Pre-K submission:

- **PK-SCHOOL-TYPE (E1555)** indicates the PK program offered at the campus.
- PK-SCHOOL-TYPE is reported as part of the ECDS collection and applies to a campus/course/section and is only reported for course sections that utilize Pre-K SERVICE-ID “01010000” (Pre-Kindergarten)
- LEAs that administer a partnership with a Head Start program or licensed child care provider would report one of the highlighted codes:

- ❑ If students transfer between PK campuses make sure PK course/sections are dropped too, otherwise duplicate PK Homeroom will result (**Fatal: 40110-0184** (repeats multiple times for each course section))

- ❑ LEAs should apply "-999" in the Assessment Vendor for the Score Result to show Not Assessed results on the ECDS reports. (See "ECDS Not Assessed" guidance chart in the Assessment Specifications document).
- ❑ If PK student is enrolled in a student section on the day the BOY PK assessment is administered, but did not take the test for whatever reason (Ex: Absent, Opted out by parent, ARD exempt etc.) then should have a score of "-999".
 - ❑ Confirm this with vendor. This student will show as "ECDS Not Assessed" in ECDS reports.
- ❑ Students who were not enrolled when the assessment test was administered (withdrew before or enrolled after) should not be reported in ECDS. (do not enter -999) **(otherwise, it could give you a batch error on the Student Assessment file).**

Resolving UID issues with ECDS assessment vendors

- ❑ LEAs are responsible for providing correct Unique IDs to assessment vendors:
 - ❑ ECDS assessment vendors can request the UID0-000-005 report from an LEA which provides a listing of all enrollment events for each student who has enrolled in the reporting LEA/campus during a given school year:
 - ❑ Enroll/Withdraw Type – Type of event:
 - ❑ 01 – Enrollment 02 – Withdrawal
 - ❑ In addition to providing student enrollment/withdrawal dates, the UID-000-005 report includes Unique ID, Local ID, and Student ID information.
 - ❑ ECDS assessment vendors can utilize the report to compare and troubleshoot UID information in their own system.

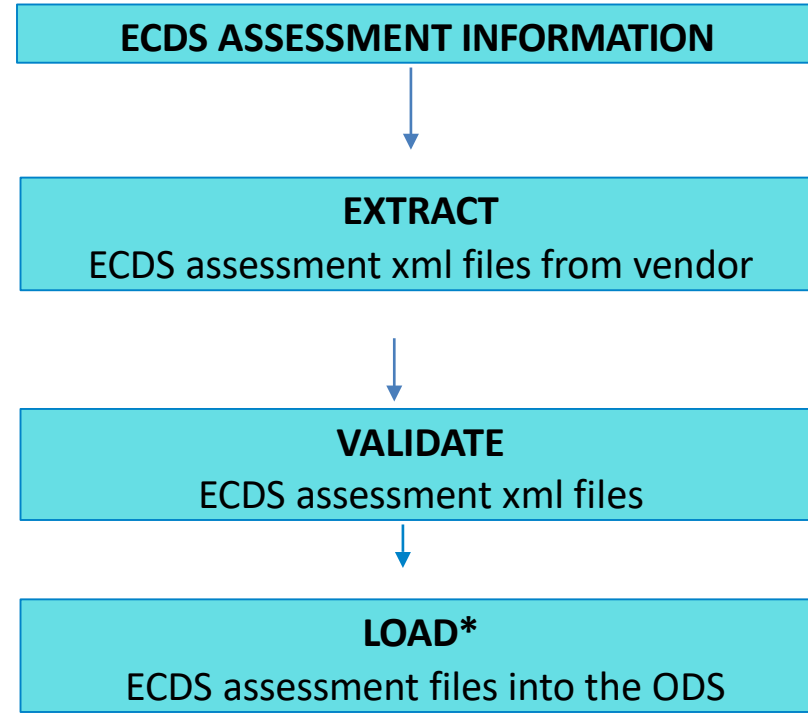
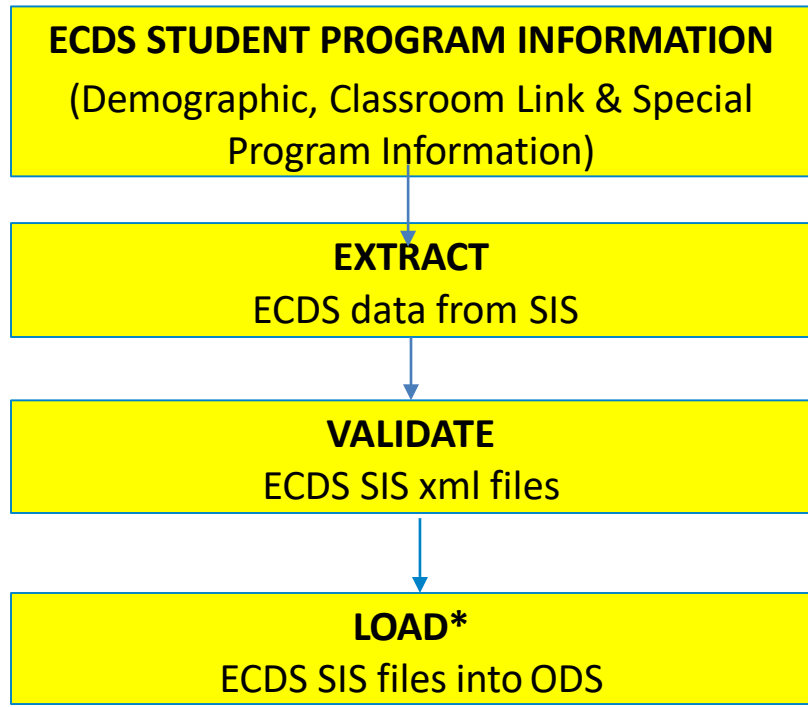


Data Flow Overview

TEAL TSDS ROLES FOR ECDS

See document: “ECDS - Requesting Access to TSDS”

Role needed to load the TSDS data files into the ODS:

ODS Data Loader - This role loads the data into the ODS.

Roles needed to promote, validate, review reports, and complete the ECDS submission:

*When requesting access, make sure to check off Privilege: **ECDS Access**

Core LEA Data Completer - This role formally certifies the completeness and accuracy of their data and submits it to TEA. This role can also schedule and monitor promotions, schedule and monitor validations, and generate reports.

Core Data Approver - This role is generally for the Superintendent or his/her designee at the LEA. It allows the LEA to request an extension for the ECDS submission in extreme situations.

Core LEA Data Promoter - This role initiates the promotion that copies the data over from the ODS. It can schedule/monitor promotions, validations, and generate reports.

Core LEA Data Viewer - This role can monitor data promotions, data validations and generate reports.

Role needed to submit help desk tickets to TEA:

TIMS L1 Support - This role can submit help desk tickets through the TSDS Incident Management System (TIMs)

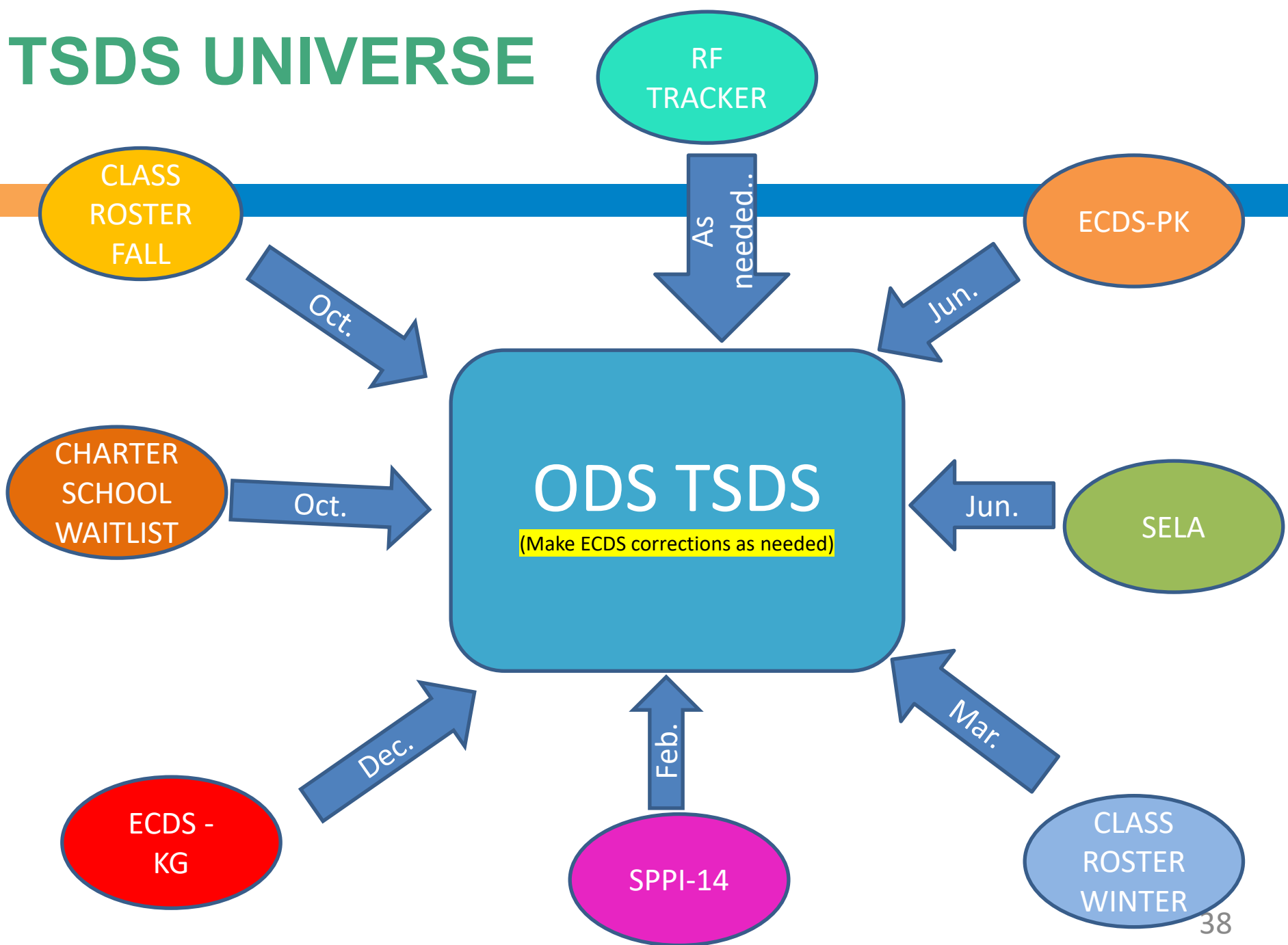
