DUAL LANGUAGE EDUCATION ADVANTAGES

VIETNAMESE DUAL LANGUAGE INSTRUCTIONAL MODEL

The Vietnamese Dual Language Program follows an instructional model in which 50 percent of curriculum is taught in Vietnamese and 50 percent in English. The program is implemented in the One-Way or Two-Way Dual Language classrooms.

Students from pre-K to 5th Grade will learn:

- Math in Vietnamese
- Social Studies in Vietnamese
- Language Arts in English
- Science in English





"ONE-WAY" OR "TWO-WAY" CLASSROOMS

One-Way Dual Language Classrooms support groups of students that speak a single language to become bilingual, bicultural, and biliterate.

Two-Way Dual Language Classrooms support groups of students that speak two or more languages to become bilingual, bicultural, and biliterate.
