




#### WHAT IS ARMY ROTC?

- When a Cadet graduates with a Bachelors or Masters degree and has completed the ROTC requirements, he or she then accepts a commission as a Second Lieutenant (2LT) in the United States Army
- Prior to graduation the Cadet is awarded their career branch (Job) and component

  - **Texas National Guard**
  - Army Reserves

#### Why else an Army Officer?



- Fast Tracking Promotions (CPT/0-3 by 48 months) and Guaranteed Raise every 2 years
- FREE Job Skills Your college degree and Army Job don't have to match
- Job Security & Career Map Don't have to stress or worry about what's next
- Federal and State agencies look for Military Experience
- Fortune 500 companies (i.e. Coca-Cola, Amazon, Boeing, Lockheed-Martin, JP Morgan, etc.) look for Military Officers
  - They can teach you their business model, but <u>they can't teach the</u> <u>management skills you have</u>

## **Army ROTC Scholarship Types**



- National Scholarship Compete against high school students across the US for semester-by-semester scholarships
  - Final Application (3<sup>rd</sup> Round) for the AY 25-26 due 17 MAR 2025
- Campus Scholarship Compete against those not selected for national for a semester-by-semester scholarships
- \$1,200 annually for books/supplies and can select \$6,000 room and board in place of tuition (not both)
- UTRGV ROTC Merit Based Scholarship/Grant Compete against only those in UTRGV ROTC Program
  - Awarded on a semester-by-semester basis
  - Only pay UTRGV bill/debt
  - Must pass HT/WT, ACFT, and have min 2.0 GPA

\*\*Not all ROTC programs have an opportunity like this\*\*



### **Army ROTC Scholarship Requirements**



- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be between the ages of 17 and 31 when commission
- Have a high school GPA of at least 2.50
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Taken the SAT or ACT
- Meet the physical weight and height requirements (varies by age and gender)
- Take the Army Combat Fitness Test (ACFT)
- Agree to accept a commission and serve in the Army on Active Duty, in the Army Reserves, or Army National Guard
