

Purpose: Assessment of demonstrated student skills;

- Not a faculty evaluation
- Not assessed by the following:
  - Course Grade
  - Gut instincts and/or Met for all scores without assessment



Goal: Reliable and valid data that informs instruction, curriculum and departmental decisions related to student learning



**Call for Action:** Collaborative effort to prioritize the relevance of student learning outcomes (Accreditation)

- How many? How are they graded? Is there a rubric?
