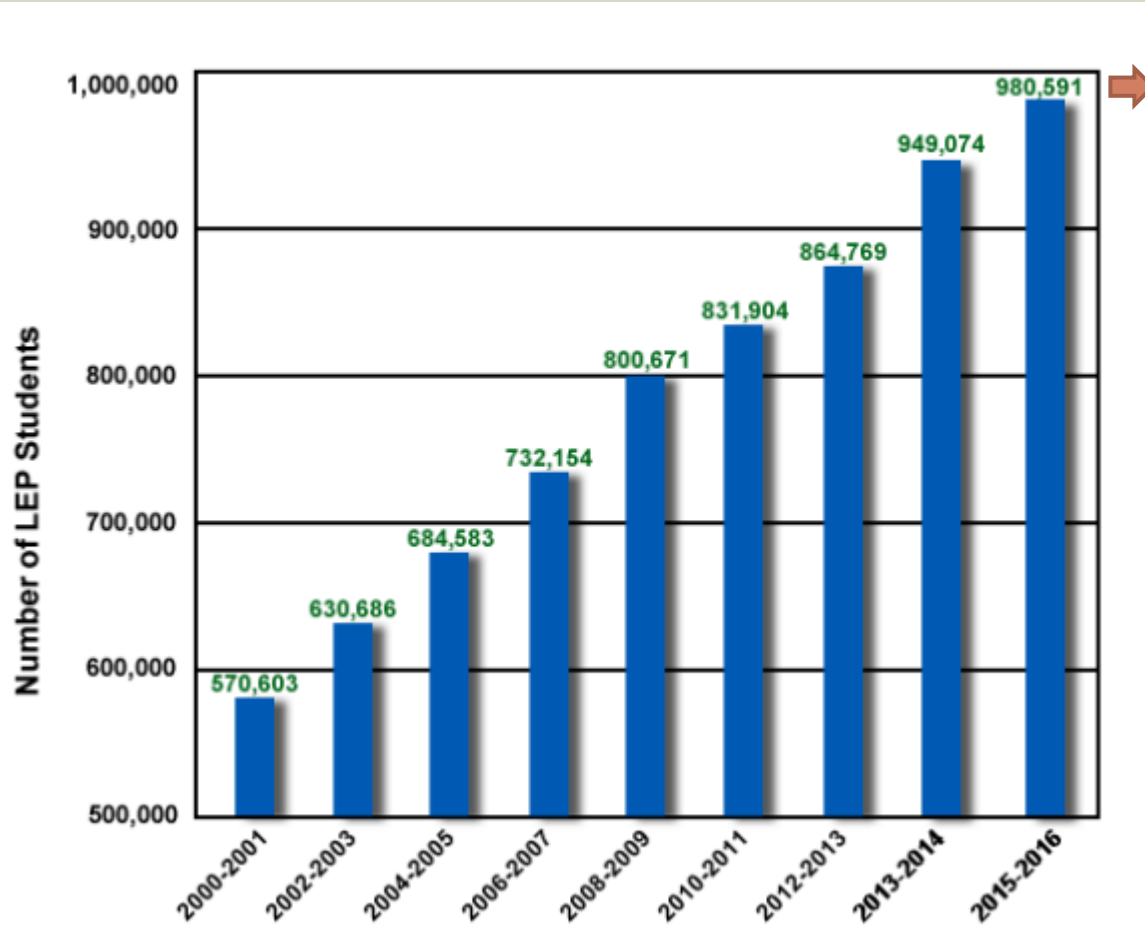

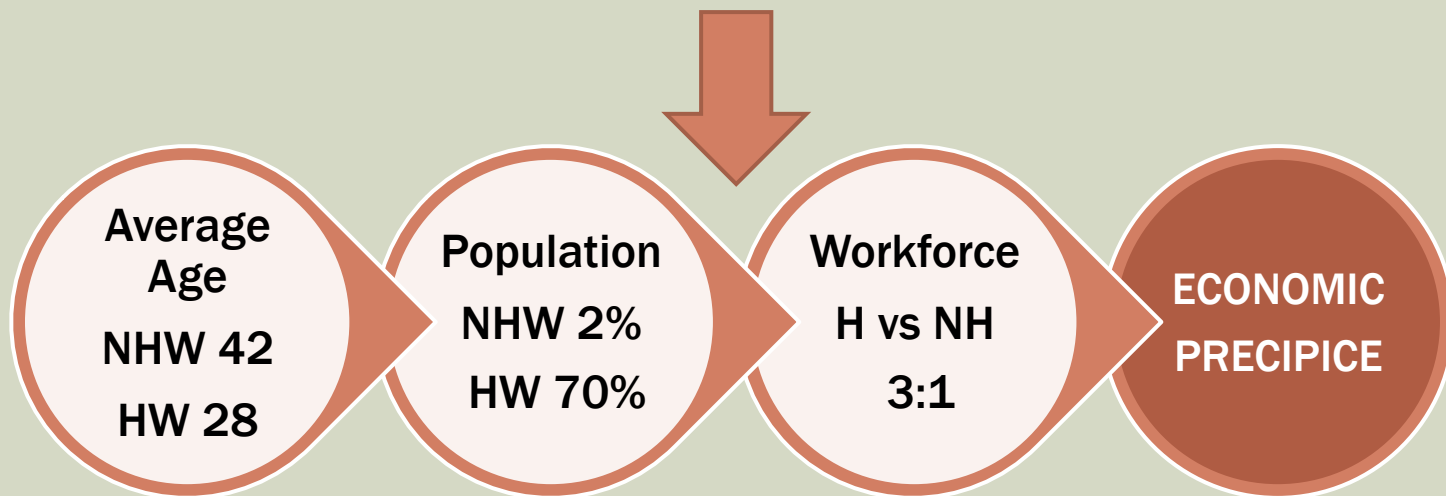

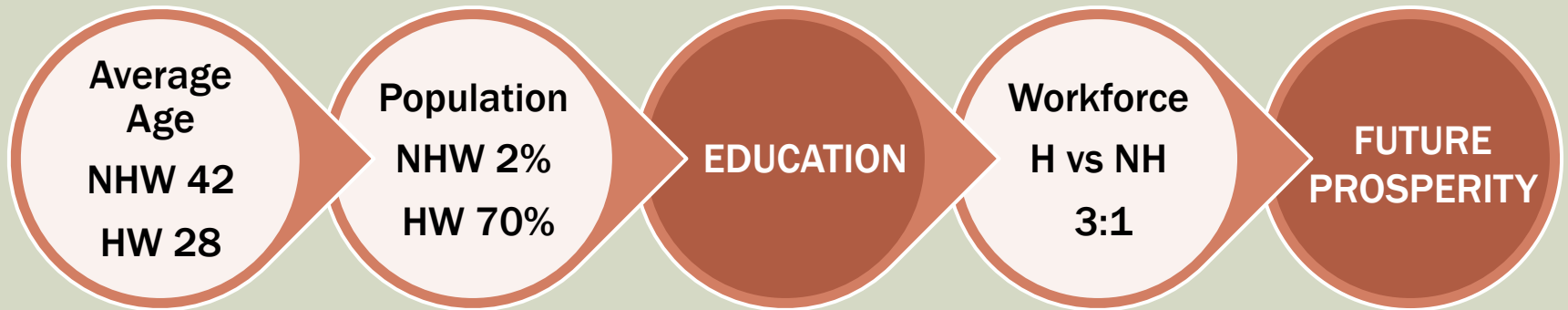
CHANGING TEXAS: 2050



“In the **absence of change**, the Texas labor force as a whole will be less-educated, work in lower-status occupations, and have lower incomes in 2050 than 2010”

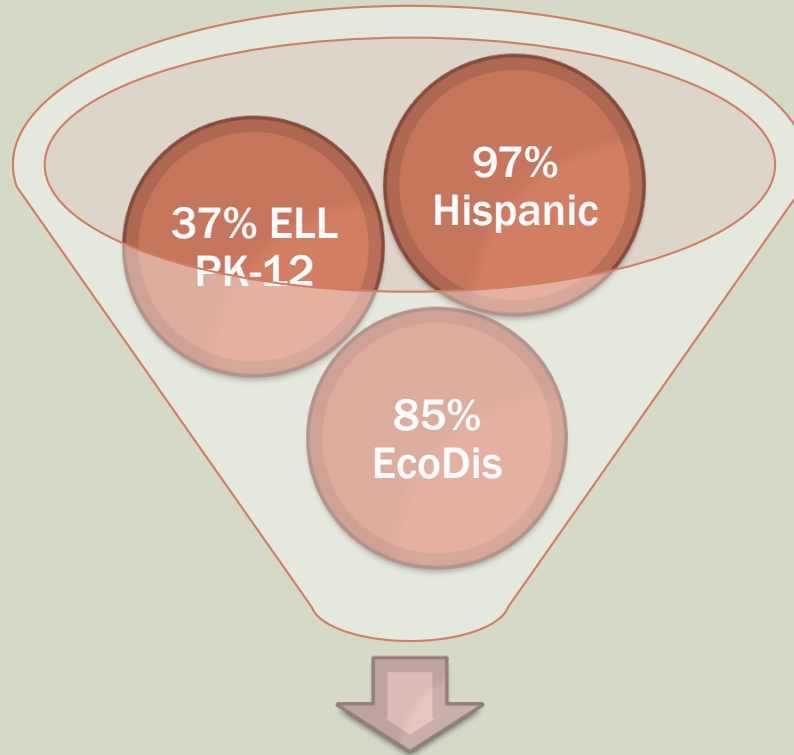

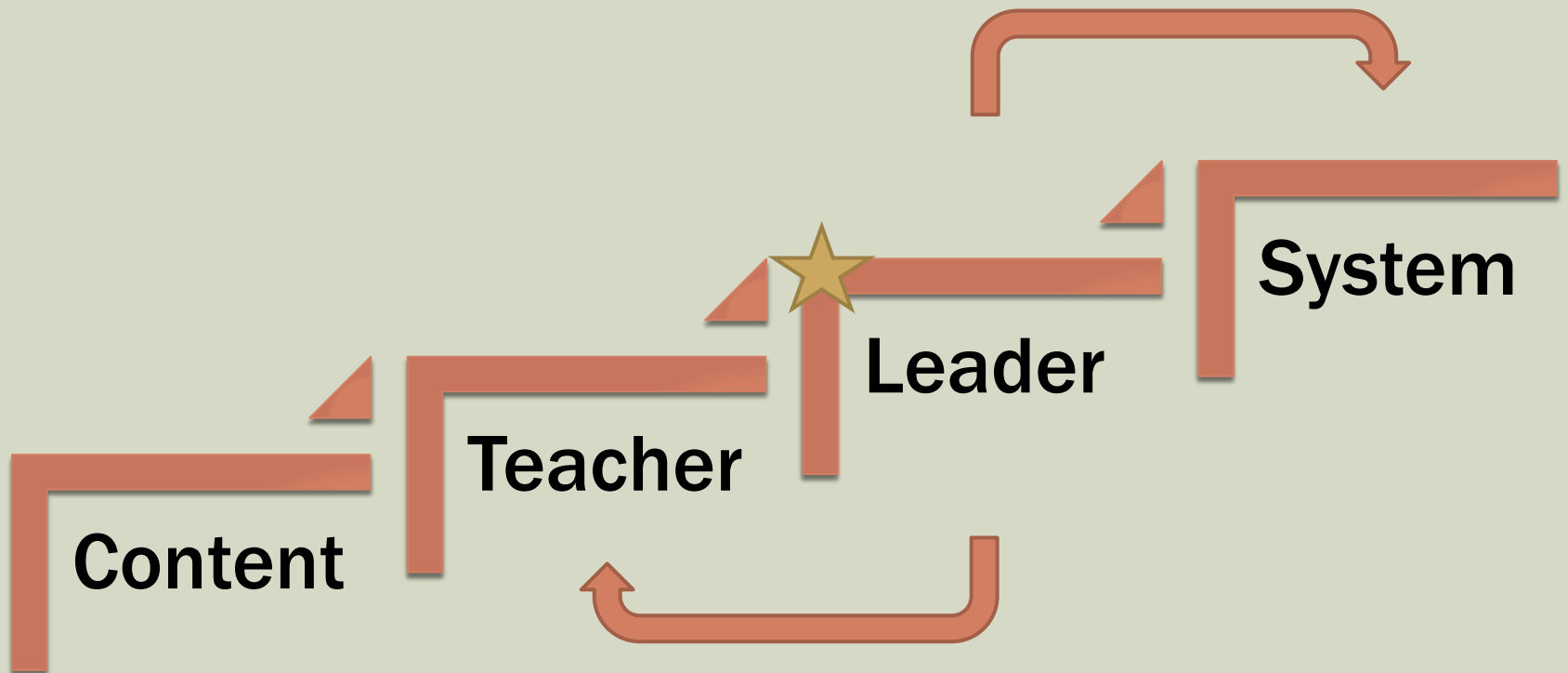

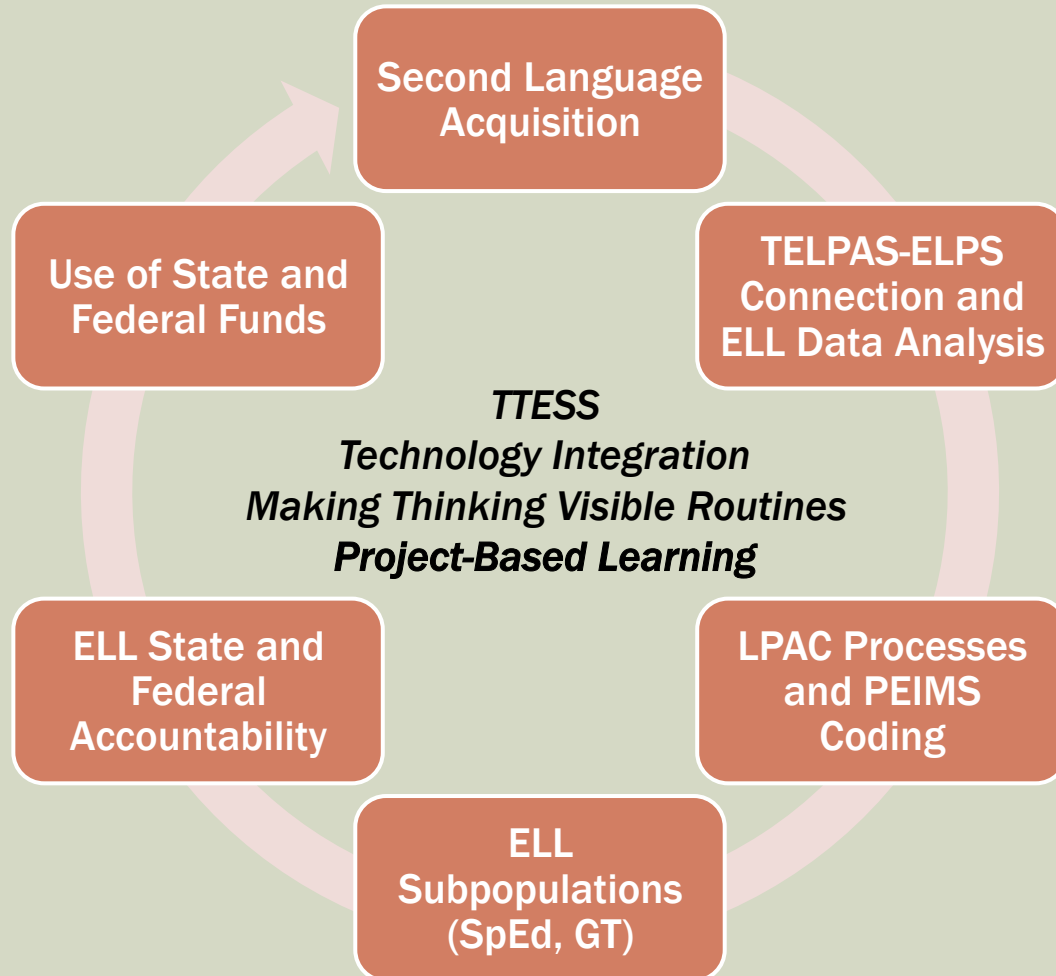
