









Job Postings vs. Hires



RGV Healthcare Industry Future Demands



- Growing Healthcare Industry
 - Additional RN educators needed in order to be able to produce sufficient RN's to meet healthcare demands
- Need for Skilled Professionals (RN)
 - A robust pipeline to supply RN's to meet the healthcare demands for the growing and aging population, more qualified applicants must be admitted into the workforce.


