Literacy means.....

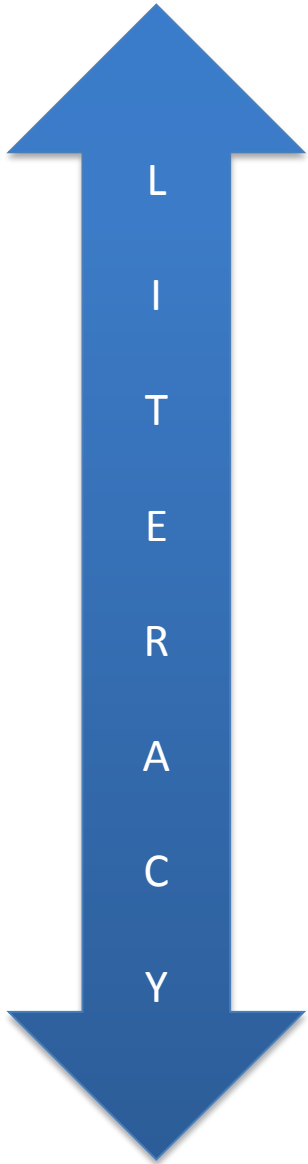

- The ability to comprehend texts, the ability and motivation to read for learning and for pleasure, and the ability to speak and write about what we've read.

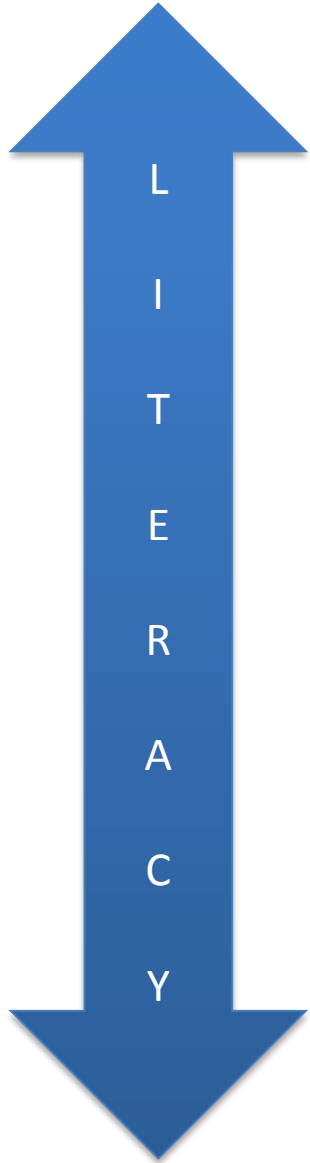

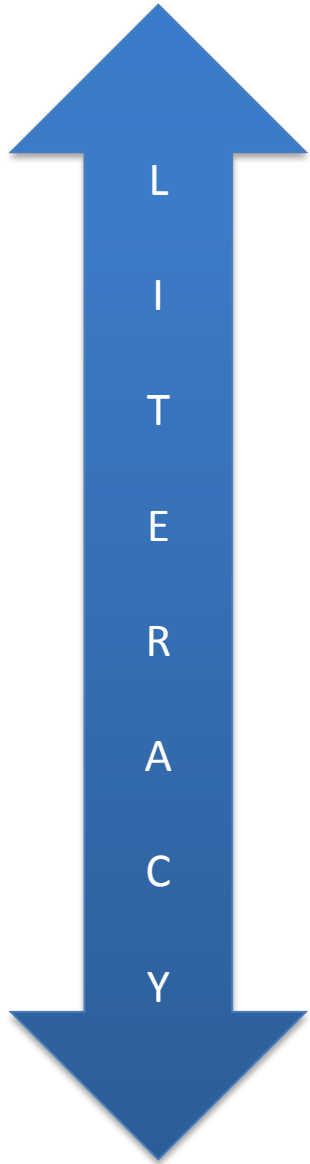


The Big Six are the Literacy skills researchers say people need in order to be successful in the workplace or higher education.

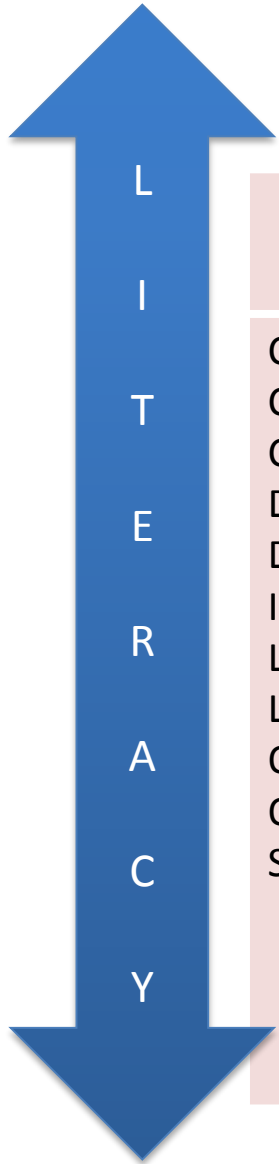

How do we know the Big Six Skills are important?

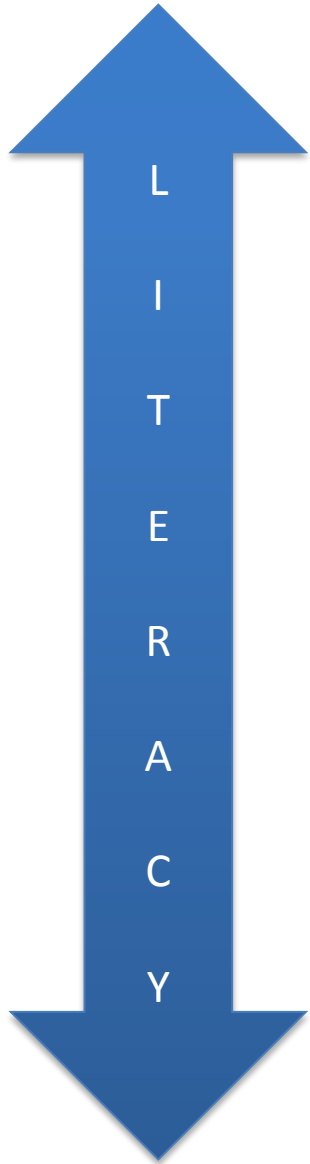


- Directly linked to most items on most reading placement tests.
