V. TEXES PPR Exam (160)

PPR Mock Exam Dates and partnered PPR Prep Sessions are identified in the schedule. Attendance at the earliest mock exam and prep session is required. A score of 80 on PPR Mock Exam is required for PPR release. End of December is the target for passing the TEXES PPR exam.

VI. Internship

Field Supervisors will conduct five observations and provide feedback during your internship. The first three are to be conducted during the first half of the internship and the last two observations conducted during the last half of the internship. Observations will be at least 45 minutes in duration. A pre and post-observation conference will be conducted for each observation.
