Program Information

Am I eligible for the Project P.a.C.E. Alternative Certification Program (ACP) for teachers?

Eligibility Requirements

- o Bachelor's Degree
- 2.5 GPA or 2.75 in last 60 hours of all coursework (Use online GPA calculator if needed)
- Basic Skills in Reading, Written and Oral Communication and Mathematics
 - 6 hours of English Language Arts coursework from an accredited university whose language of instruction is English
 - 3 hours of college level mathematics or equivalent
- Cannot have taught for 3 years or more on a permit or certificate
- Cannot have been admitted to another Educator Preparation Program (EPP)-University or ACP (Transfer possible with completed PACT exams in a different area)
- Pass Pre-Admission Content Tests (PACT)
- Access to a computer, internet, and e-mail

Out of Country Basic Skills Requirements

- TOEFL iBT speaking score of at least 24 speaking, 22 listening, 22 reading, and 21 for writing to demonstrate English language proficiency. Test information at http://www.ets.org/toefl/.
- Transcript evaluation into US degree equivalency by a credential evaluation service

What is the Process for Program Acceptance?

- 1. Complete PACT Content Area Testing
 - Registering for PACT Content Exams

- Note: The name you create on your TEA account and your ETS testing account must exactly match the name on the ID documents you will present on the day of the test.



2. Application Process

- Fill out online application sent by program staff
- o Pay \$40.00 non-refundable application fee through link sent by program staff
- o Submit official transcripts from ALL universities and colleges attended
 - CTE Candidates submit SOQ, copy and verification of licenses,
 - Foreign Transcripts See TEA website:
 http://tea.texas.gov/Texas_Educators/Certification/Out-ofState Certification/Foreign Credential Evaluation Services/

3. Screening and Selection Process

- Submit PACT Scores
- Transcript Review for Suggested Certification Areas
- o Interview by Program Staff
- Check for Competency in Basic Skills
- Pay \$55.00 TEA Technology Fee (Admitted on or after March 17, 2017)
- o Pay \$295 Pre-Service Training Fee

4. Acceptance into P.a.C.E.

What is the P.a.C.E. Coursework Schedule?

Pre-Service Training

- Program Introduction/Orientation
- Field-based Experience Observations (30 hours required prior to teaching)
- Summer Institute/Coursework (150 program hours required prior to teaching) Program meets Fridays and Saturdays during June, July (Two week ESC1 Closure), and first week in August
 - Note: All candidates are required to complete 150 hours of course work and 30 field-based experience observation hours prior to teaching.

In-Service Training

- Ongoing Professional Saturday Seminars- September through May
- Thursday Evening Seminars- September through May

The CAL may be used to cover part or all of the student's Expected Family Contribution (EFC); students do not have to demonstrate financial need. This federally funded program is designed to assist military personnel and veterans transition to a new career as a public-school teacher. Through a network of national, state, and regional offices, participants receive guidance counseling, and provide funding to eligible participants to help pay for their certification programs and incentive bonuses for those who teach at high-needs schools.

PACT Exam Information Brief

You are eligible to take the Pre-Admission Content Test (PACT) exam if:

- 1. You hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited university (http://ope.ed.gov/accreditation/.)
- 2. You are seeking initial certification as a classroom teacher requiring no specific skill and experience requirements
- 3. You have NOT been enrolled or accepted into an alternative certification program

To register for the exam:

- 1. Go to www.texes.ets.org
- 2. Click on "register"
- 3. Scroll down, then click "new user"
- 4. Select "No TEA ID"
- 5. Select "Pre-Admission Content Tests"
- 6. Enter required data for account registration
- 7. Select "register for a test"

Please note: The PACT is simply the route that allows you to take examinations without being affiliated with a particular educator program. The test for which you register is not called PACT, it is called TEXES. **A passing score on the PACT does not guarantee admittance to the program.** Scores must be sent by the student to our office as we do not receive them from ETS.
